## Jewish Family Service of New Mexico Receives Grant for Seniors Aging Well At Home Program

**Albuquerque, New Mexico** – Jewish Family Service of New Mexico (JFS) announced today that it has received an \$85,000 Daniels Fund grant to support its Aging Well At Home Program for seniors.

JFS, established in 1985, has a rich tradition of providing assistance to those in need so they can overcome their challenges. The grant will also help JFS to bring our Housekeeper/Companion service to Santa Fe residents; offer case management and medication management services to seniors on location at The Storehouse; and provide a new transportation service to Rio Rancho seniors. Our services allow seniors to continue living independently in their own homes and we are grateful for the support of Daniels Fund.” said Michael Gemme, Executive Director.
